## **Disciplinary Committee ordered member excluded/\***

On 15 August 2025, the Disciplinary Committee of ACCA (the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants) found proved the following allegations against Miss Yan Li of Chengdu, China:

### Allegations

Yan Li ('Miss Li'), at all material times an ACCA trainee,

1. Failed to co-operate with ACCA's Investigating Officer in breach of Complaints and Disciplinary Regulation 3(1) in that she failed to respond fully or at all to any or all of ACCA's correspondence dated:
  - a) 13 October 2023
  - b) 30 October 2023
  - c) 14 November 2023
  
2. By reason of her conduct, Miss Li is:
  - a) Guilty of misconduct pursuant to ACCA bye-law 8(a)(i) in respect of any or all the matters set out at 1 above.

The Disciplinary Committee ordered that Miss Li be excluded from ACCA membership and to pay costs to ACCA in the sum of £5,340.

Please note that this may be the subject of an appeal.

ACCA's regulations require ACCA to publish the Committee's findings and orders by way of a news release, as soon as practicable.

*\* An order made by the Disciplinary Committee shall take effect from the date of expiry of the Appeal Period referred to in the Appeal Regulations unless the Committee directs that the order should have immediate effect*
