Disciplinary Committee ordered member excluded*

On 15 April 2026, the Disciplinary Committee of ACCA (the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants) found proved the following allegations against Mr Peng Meng of Singapore:

Allegations

Mr Peng Meng, a member of Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (“ACCA”):

1. On or about 26 December 2023, Mr Meng submitted or caused to be submitted to ACCA, false documents namely a Bachelor of Science in Accounting with Specialization in Professional Accountancy dated 06 June 2018 (the “Certificate”) and/or an Examination Transcript dated 12 June 2018 (the “Transcript”), purportedly issued by University A in support of his application for exemptions.
2. Mr Meng’s conduct at Allegation 1 above:
 - a) Was dishonest, in that he knew the Certificate and/or Transcript he submitted or caused to be submitted to ACCA were false.
3. Contrary to Regulation 3 (1) of the Complaints and Disciplinary Regulations 2014, Mr Meng failed to co-operate with the investigation of a complaint in that he failed to respond to any or all of ACCA’s correspondence dated:
 - a) 11 November 2025
 - b) 26 November 2025
 - c) 08 December 2025

4. By reason of the conduct described in any or all of the allegations set out above, Mr Meng is:

a) Guilty of misconduct pursuant to bye-law 8(a)(i).

The Disciplinary Committee ordered that Mr Peng Meng be excluded from ACCA membership with immediate effect and to pay costs to ACCA in the sum of £6,529.00.

Please note that this may be the subject of an appeal.

ACCA's regulations require ACCA to publish the Committee's findings and orders by way of a news release, as soon as practicable.

** An order made by the Disciplinary Committee shall take effect from the date of expiry of the Appeal Period referred to in the Appeal Regulations unless the Committee directs that the order should have immediate effect*
