Notice of hearing

A hearing of ACCA's Disciplinary Committee will take place at 08:00am on 27 May 2026. It will be held remotely but based at the ACCA's Offices, The Adelphi, 1-11 John Adam Street, London, WC2N 6AU.

The case to be heard on this day concerns Mr Ivan Chan Chuk Cheung.

Allegations

Mr Ivan Chan Chuk Cheung, an ACCA member:

- 1) On 10 October 2023 had a disciplinary finding made against him by the Securities and Future Commission (SFC), a professional or regulatory body.
- 2) By reason of Allegation 1, Mr Ivan Chan Chuk Cheung is:
 - (i) Liable to disciplinary action pursuant to bye-law 8(a)(vi).
- 3) Further to allegations 1 and 2, between 11 October 2023 and 14 March 2025, failed to bring promptly to the attention of ACCA any facts or matters indicating that he may have become liable to disciplinary action by reason of having a disciplinary finding made against him by the SFC on 10 October 2023, contrary to bye-law 10(b).
- 4) By reason of any or all of his conduct Mr Chan Chuk Cheung is:

- a) Guilty of misconduct and liable to disciplinary action pursuant to bye-law 8(a)(i); or in the alternative:
- b) Liable to disciplinary action pursuant to bye-law 8(a)(iii).

The allegations listed above are current at the date of publication.

The case will be heard by a panel of the ACCA's Disciplinary Committee.
